## **Groundbreaking Ceremony for new Lyndhurst Junior High School @ 4:30 PM on October 11, 2016**

*Lyndhurst, New Jersey, October 3, 2016* - The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Lyndhurst will conduct a groundbreaking ceremony with the Board of Education for the new Lyndhurst Junior High School on October 11, 2016 at 4:30 PM. The Groundbreaking ceremony will take place at Matera field, the site the new Lyndhurst Junior High School.

The new Lyndhurst Junior High School will be a Center of Academic Excellence and serve the 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grades. It will provide relief and expansion opportunities to the existing High School and elementary schools. The approximately 110,000 square foot Junior High School will include a three story academic wing, a visual and performing arts theater, and a full size gymnasium with auxiliary gym, locker rooms, weight room and an athletic field. The academic facilities will include a state-of-the-art culinary arts facility and active learning classrooms. It will also provide for instruction in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM).

The new Lyndhurst Junior High School is part of our commitment to Renewing our Schools and Community with a Dedication to Excellence. The new Junior High School replaces the 130 year old Lincoln School as part of the redevelopment of Township facilities.
